Please ask this community member to indicate how long they have known you and in what capacity.
- III. Personal Statement: In this section, please provide a response to both of the questions listed below. Applicants have the option of submitting responses in written form in no more than 250 words max or emailing a video response (2 minutes maximum) to accpischolarships@gmail.com. If you choose to send a video response, please ensure that your recording is done in bright lighting and preferably mp4, m4v and/or m04 format.
 - 1. What are your career aspirations and how do you plan to use your scholarship funds to further your academic and professional goals?
 - Which of your community service or Co-Op/OYAP experiences have left the most profound impact on you and why? Reflect on any skills that you acquired, and lessons learned through-out your participation and share how they have prepared you for your desired career path.
